(Prerequisite: EDUC 4110)

(Differentiated Curriculum and Instruction) (2 hours)  
(Prerequisite: EDUC 4200 or concurrent enrollment)

**EDUC 4110G** (2 hours)  
(Behavior Support and Classroom Management)

**EDUC 4200G** (2 hours)  
(Principles of Assessment, Teaching, and Learning)

**EDUC 4210G** (2 hours)  
(Human Development)

### LEVEL 2

(General Prerequisites: Successful Completion of Level 1 coursework)

(Secondary and Transition Issues)  
(Prerequisite: EDSP 4030G or concurrent enrollment)

**EDUC 4852** (Prerequisite: EDUC 4851) (1 hour)  
Internship III (Performance Review: Level 2 Assessment)  
**MUST BE TAKEN DURING THE LAST SEMESTER OF COURSEWORK**

### LEVEL 3

**(ALL Coursework and Internships I, II and III MUST BE COMPLETED)**

**EDUC 4853** (3 hours)  
(Capstone Internship)

Or

**EDUC 4960** (3 hours)  
(Student Teaching)

### PRESCRIPTIVE PLAN

(Individualized coursework if needed – not to exceed 4 hours)  
(minimum grade of “C” required in each course)

**EDUC 4901** (1 hour)

**EDUC 4903** (3 hours)

**NOTE:** Only 4000 level “G” courses can be applied towards a Master’s degree

(Individual departments will determine the # of hours accepted towards a Master’s degree)
